Background

- The Madison County Health Department was created in 1994 by County Board [Resolution](#) that declared all 29 County Board Members would also serve as Members of the Board of Health.
- 7 County Board Members are appointed to serve on the County Health Department Committee.



Background Continued

- This is in contrast to a Health Department created by Referendum, i.e. a public election, where Board of Health Members are usually elected similar to Boards of Education.

Background Continued

- The County Board of Health is the County Board, yet they are 2 quite separate organizations.
- They have differing missions as well as legal-ethical responsibilities.
- Madison and Kane Counties are the only 2 counties in the State where the County Board serves this dual role.



County Boards who decide to be their own Board of Health, by law must appoint a health oriented Advisory Committee of at least five members (of which one is a physician, one a dentist, and one a nurse) to advise the County Board of Health on matters where advanced knowledge of health, in particular public health is required.



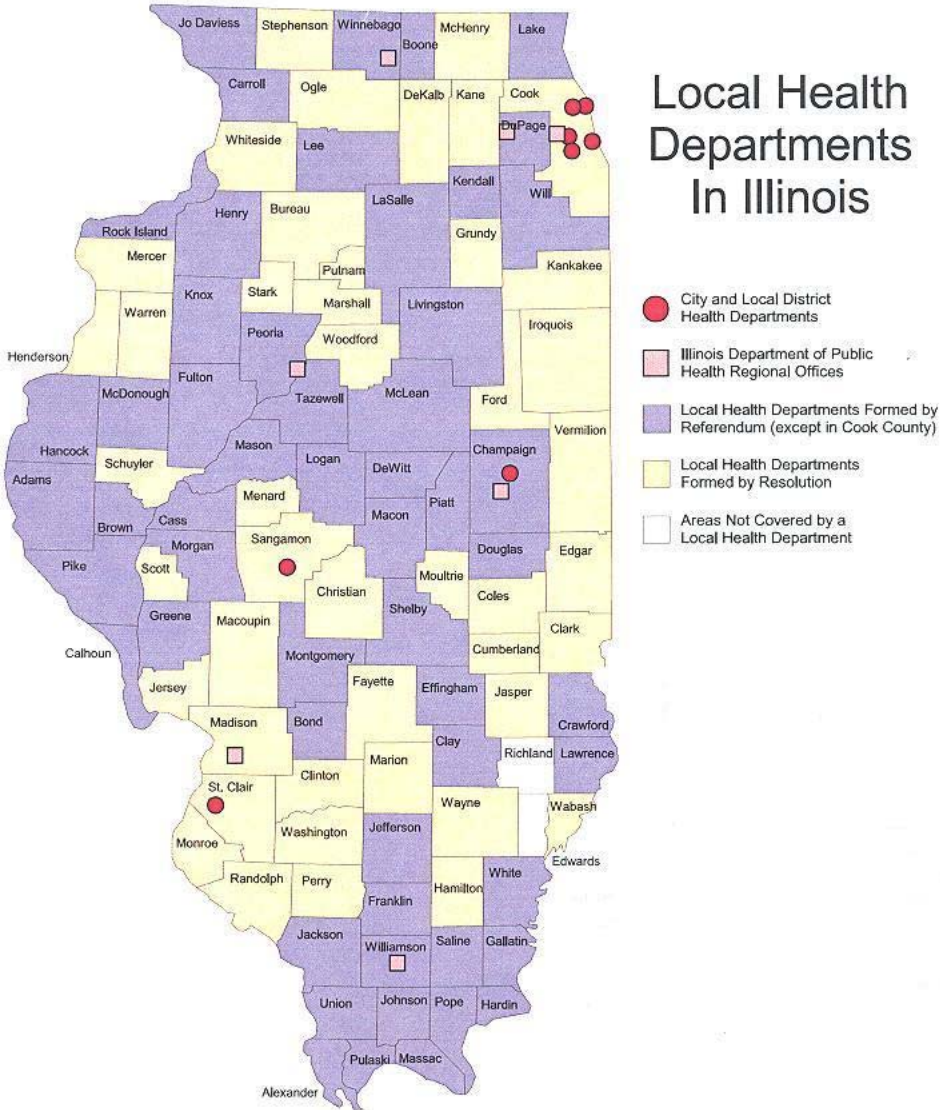
